

#### 2025 GREAT PLAINS ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Guest speakers and memorable points or quotes by speakers:

- Bishop Gregory V. Palmer "We've got this notion that we want to go to church, and we don't
  want to be disturbed" ... "What if the United Methodist Church said, 'We're gonna love the zip
  code, and we're going to know everybody by name'?"
- Dr. Ashley Boggan An "historic context for a Wesley way of discovering God."
- Bishop Bruce Blake Frequently intoning "clanging symbols and noisy gongs" from 1 Corinthians 13:1 and the concept of agape love, Bishop Bruce Blake told Great Plains Conference ordinands that they're carrying on centuries of tradition, from Biblical times to Methodist circuit riders.
- Bishop David Wilson "We are called to be people who know there is much to do in our communities and in our churches. People need our loving, serving and prophetic voices to know that God is still so ever present. Folks need to know that there is more that we can do, not on our own, but being led by the Holy Spirit. We will do this because of our Love for God that drives us to do all that we do. Like the Exodus story, may we never forget what God has done for us in the past, but more importantly, that God will continue to be so faithful to us for our future

#### **Budget**

The conference passed a spending plan of \$14,421,442, down 5% from 2025 spending plan passed at the 2024 annual conference and flat to an adjusted spending plan adapted earlier in 2025. Other resolutions adopted by the conference:

- Show support for Medicaid expansion in Kansas.
- Rejection of the tenets of Christian Nationalism.
- Change in Parental Leave Policy to allow clergy to be on leave for up to 13 weeks with full compensation.
- Establishing a Caretaker of God's Creation Coordinator, as encouraged by the 2020/2024 General Conference.
- Transition to Clean Energy by creating a task force to assist congregations to work toward carbon-neutral footprints for their buildings.
- Affirming World Methodist Council and World Council of Churches' call to end genocide in Palestine.

Main actions enacted by the conference: The Great Plains Conference voted on four proposed amendments to the United Methodist constitution, all of which passed overwhelmingly at the 2020/2024 General Conference. These included:

- Regionalization Would transform the United States to a regional conference and rename central conferences as regional conferences for United Methodists outside the United States.
- Inclusiveness of the Church Adds the words "gender" and "ability" to a list of descriptions to
  which people will not be measured for being allowed to participate in the full life of the church.
- Racial Justice Adds a statement that racism must be eradicated and that The United Methodist Church commits to doing its part to confront and eliminate racism, racial inequity, colonialism, white privilege and white supremacy in society.
- Educational Requirements for Clergy Impacting mostly central conferences (outside the United States). We may not know the results until late fall of this year.
